GREENSBORO—The North Carolina Writers' Network 2016 Spring Conference will be held Saturday, April 23, in the MHRA Building and Curry Auditorium on the campus of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Registration is now open.

Michael Parker, of Greensboro, will give the Keynote Address. Michael is the author of six novels, including All I Have in This World, and two collections of short stories. He has received fellowships in fiction from the North Carolina Arts Council and the National Endowment for the Arts, as well as the North Carolina Award for Literature. A graduate of UNC-Chapel Hill and the University of Virginia, he is the Vacc Distinguished

Professor in the MFA WritingProgram at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and since 2009 has been on the faculty of the Warren Wilson Program for Writers.

Quinn Dalton, author of the novel High Strung, will lead the Fiction Master Class, "Make a Scene: Learn How to Use the Emotional Building Blocks of Fiction." Midnight Bowling, her next novel, will be published by Carolina Wren Press in March. The Infinity of You & Me, a novel co-written with novelist and poet Julianna Baggott under the pen name J.Q. Coyle, is forthcoming from Harper Collins in the fall of 2016.
